Heirs: Reddick Smith and his wife Tabitha<sup>1</sup>, Reddick Smith as guardian of Martha M Donald<sup>3</sup>, Fata Ursula Donald<sup>3</sup>, Martha M Parker<sup>2</sup>, Simion E Donald<sup>5</sup> of Attala County, and Rufus H Donald of Madison County, Mary Jane Register<sup>3</sup> and husband Tilman Register of Florida, Francis Ann Sunday<sup>4</sup> and her husband Augustus Sunday of Texas.
